

### HOW TO PLAY

- 2. Open and close (front to back and sideways) once for each letter in the name of the colour selected. e.g. red would be opened and closed three times
- Choose one of the number words showing and open and close once for each letter in the number selected. For example: nine would be opened and closed four times
- Choose one of the four maths problems shown inside and answer it. Lift the the question to check your answer




### LET'S GET STARTED

- Cut out your fortune teller and colour it in. Place the square face up and fold and unfold the square in diagonals from corner to corner so you end up with 'X' shape creases
- Place the square facedown and fold each of the four corners in so the points meet in the centre
- Turn the paper over so the flaps are now face down. Fold each of the four corners in so the points meet in the centre











. Pinch the top corners together with the thumbs and fingers under the flaps to form a point
